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After School Child Care

Following the success of our Breakfast Club, we are proposing to run a similar after school provision from 3.15pm until 4pm initially. This will be available for all School children (Yr R to 6) and will include a drink and biscuit (or similar) and a rolling programme of activities such as colouring, iPads, lego, action figures, cartoons, games etc. As this is child care rather than a School activity, there will initially be a charge of £3 per pupil per session. The School is not looking to make a significant profit from this provision so we may be able to reduce costs or provide a discount for 2 or more children.

As with Breakfast Club, we are expecting take up of this provision to start slowly and build to a point at which it becomes financially viable. The Governors are therefore committing to run the club for the remainder of the Summer Term and into the 2017/18 financial year. The club will not finish without considerable notice or consultation and it will run every School day (unless there are no children attending!).

We hope this gives you the confidence to use the provision without worry that childcare may be available one week and not the next!

School Buildings Update

There are a few bits of finishing off and tidying up to be completed by the builders before our new building is formally completed. We are very pleased with the additional space and facilities the new build has given the School.

Swirls Class with Miss Allen and Stripes Class with Miss Elson have also moved into their new classrooms which were repainted over the Easter Holiday. We are intending to move Pre School into Miss Allen's old classroom by the time the children return to school after half term. This room will be repainted too and then we can move onto sorting out what will be the Nursery room next door.

The library (in Mrs Holt's old room) is also a bit of a work in progress! It is currently usable as a library and we have ordered furniture that has been a target for the School's fundraising over the last year or so. This room will look fantastic when we can redecorate and get all our books out and available for the children, as well as investing in some new ones.

Next academic year we will be looking at developing and improving our outside areas around the school site making more and different spaces accessible for learning and play.
